BACKGROUND:

The City of Spokane must take legislative action to updates its Shoreline Master Program (SMP) to ensure the program complies with the Shoreline Management Act (RCW 90.58). On September 24, 2008 the Spokane Plan Commission voted unanimously to forward to the City Council a recommendation of approval of the SMP. On December 1, 2008 the City Council approved the SMP, which include an Inventory and Analysis, Goals, Policies, Regulations, and a Restoration Plan. The SMP was officially submitted to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on February 26, 2009. Ecology officially approved the SMP, with conditions with a letter dated on February 1, 2010.

ORDINANCE NO. C C 3 4 6 0 7

An ordinance ratifying changes to SMC 1.05.160 relating to land use violations due to the Shorelines Management Program; and setting an effective date.

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2008, the city council adopted Ordinance No. C34329 relating to land use violations for the City's Shoreline Management Program; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance is to be effective thirty days after its enactment in accordance with section 19 of the City of Spokane charter or the date on which the Washington State Department of Ecology approves the City's updated Shoreline Master Program as provided by RCW 90.58.090, whichever is later; and

WHEREAS, almost two years has passed and the City and Department of Ecology have agreed on one change to the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, SMC section 1.05.160 in the ordinance as passed in 2008 is now out of date due to the passage of new ordinances; and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting that council ratify the amendments in Ordinance C34329, along with the section amendments since its original adoption; -- Now, Therefore,


The City of Spokane does ordain:

Section 1. That SMC section 1.05.160 as amended by Ordinance C34329 along with Ordinances C34393, C34488, C34563 and C34567 is hereby ratified.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to make such administrative changes as necessary to the Municipal Code to bring it into compliance with this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective thirty days after its enactment in accordance with section 19 of the City of Spokane charter or the date on which the Washington State Department of Ecology approves the City's updated Shoreline Master Program as provided by RCW 90.58.090, whichever is later.
